NOTES

1. Basis of Bearing is the U.S. Bureau of Land Management record bearing between Ranges 9 and 10 West.
2. All claimants monuments were recovered except: Cor. No. 3 and Cor. No. 2, Tract G. Survey monuments were established in the immediate vicinity of claimants monuments except where moves were required due to area and water front limitations.
3. Topography is low rolling ground. Drainage is normal water runoff.
4. The tracts are subject to a 10 foot pedestrian easement along the ordinary high water line of the lake.
5. All section lines bounded by state land are subject to a 50 foot section line easement on each side, reserved to the State of Alaska for public highway under A.S.19.10.010.
6. Basis of coordinates is the published position of the Corner of Section 25,30,31 and 36 from ASLS 72-64.
7. Bearings shown hereon are true mean and distances are true.
8. Meanders shown hereon are for area computation purposes only and the true meanders of the line of mean high water form the true boundaries.
9. This survey was accomplished in accordance with O.T.E. S.I. 74-61 and A.S. 38.05.077.
