## NOTES

1. Bearing was established from line 2-3, Tract "0" of ASLS 72-64.
2. All claimants monuments were recovered. Survey monuments were established in the immediate vicinity of the claimants monument except where moves were required due to area & water frontage limitations.
3. Topography is low rolling ground. Drainage is normal water runoff.
4. The tracts are subject to a 10 ft. pedestrian easement along the ordinary high water line of the lake.
5. All section lines bounded by state land are subject to a 50 ft. section line easement on each side, reserved to the State of Alaska for public highways under A.S. 19.10.010.
6. Basis of coordinates is the U.S. Bureau of Land Management published position for the corner of Townships 21 and 22 North, Ranges 9 and 10 West.
7. Bearings shown hereon are true mean and distances are true.
8. Meanders shown hereon are for area computation purposes only and the true meanders of the line of mean high water form the true boundaries.
9. This survey was accomplished in accordance with O.T.E. S.I. 74-62 and A.S. 38.05.077.
