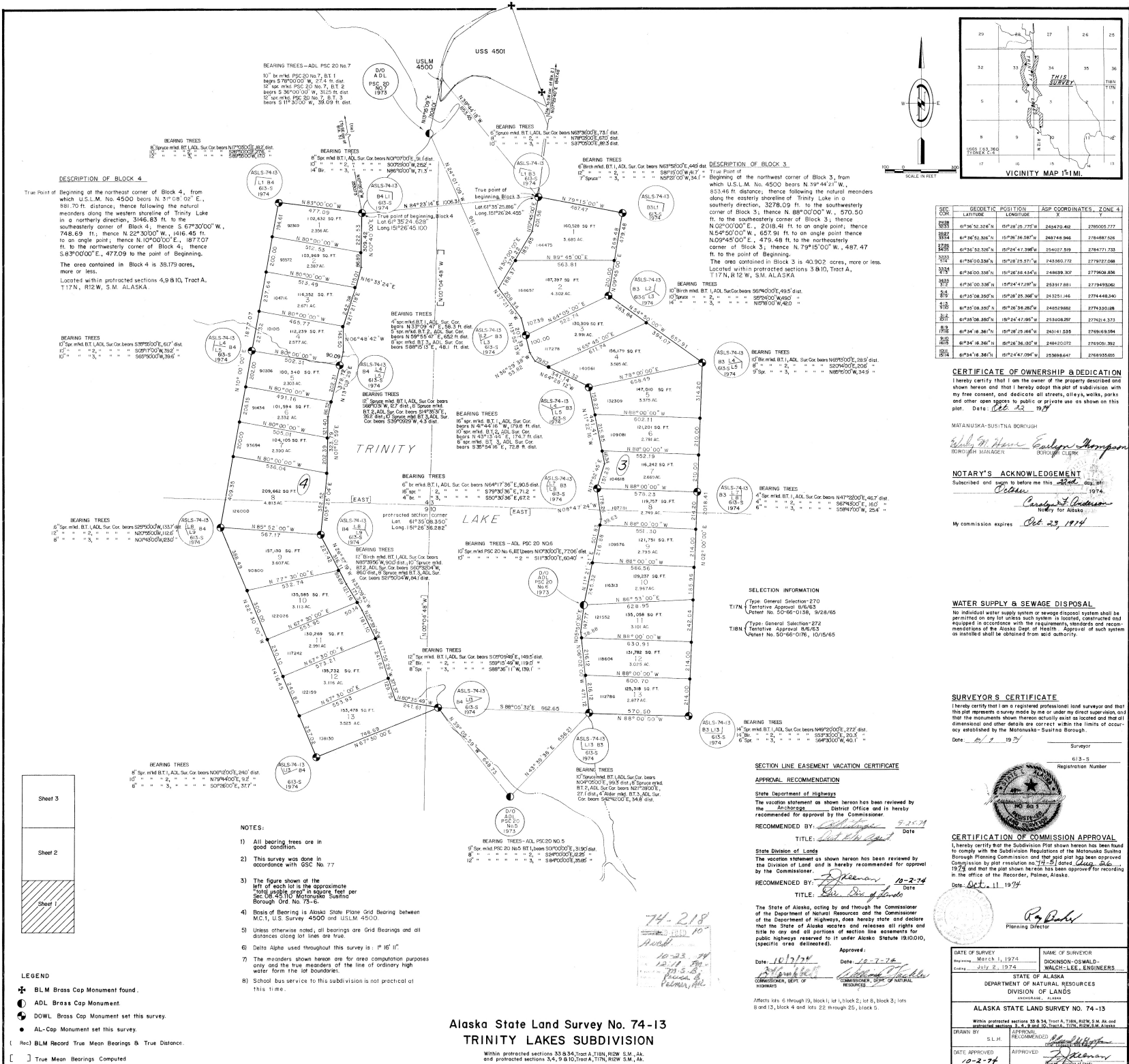




# LEGAL DESCRIPTION OF BLOCK 5.

True point of Beginning at the most southerly corner of Block 5, from which U.S.L.M. No. 4500 bears S42°20'00"E., 1887.92 ft.; thence N70°28'23"E., 432.34 ft. to the southeasterly corner of Lot 23, Block 5; thence following the natural meanders along the westerly shoreline of Trinity Lake in a northerly direction 793.26 ft. to the northeasterly corner of Block 5; thence N79°23'44"W., 796.88 ft. to an angle point; thence S37°45'00"E., 796.88 ft. to an angle point; thence S17°30'00"W., 2181.80 ft. to an angle point; thence S11°55'50"E., 1993.56 ft. to an angle point; thence S10°34'30"W., 935.86 ft. to an angle point; thence S48°00'00"E., 791.40 ft. to the point of Beginning.

# LEGAL DESCRIPTION OF BLOCK 1.

True point of Beginning at a point identical with Meander Cor. No. 2 of U.S. Survey No. 4500, Alaska, on the easterly side of Trinity Lake, said point being monumented with a standard Bureau of Land Management brass capped monument as described in the official records of that survey, said monument being at Long 161°50'02"00"W. and Long 161°50'02"00"W. from which, U.S.L.M. No. 4500 bears S09°55'44"E., 3180.01 ft. dist.; thence S75°15'54"E., on a line partially identical with line 2-3 of said U.S. Survey No. 4500, 405.13 ft. to the southeasterly corner of Block 1; thence N12°30'00"E., 1109.02 ft. to an angle point; thence N15°15'00"W., 1677.76 ft. to an angle point; thence N12°30'00"E., 2105.29 ft. to an angle point; thence N10°45'00"W., 232.02 ft. to the northeasterly corner of Block 1; thence S87°55'35"W., 346.10 ft. to a point on the easterly shoreline of Trinity Lake, thence following the natural meanders along the easterly shoreline of Trinity Lake in a southerly direction, 444.42 ft. to the Point of Beginning.

The area contained in Block 1 contains 47403 Acres, more or less.

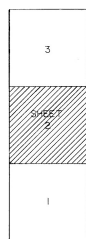

# LEGAL DESCRIPTION OF BLOCK 2.

True point of Beginning at a point identical with Meander Cor. No. 1 of U.S. Survey No. 4500, Alaska, previously described, from which U.S.L.M. No. 4500 bears S09°55'27"E., 2469.50 ft. distance, thence following the natural meanders of the easterly shore of Trinity Lake in a southeasterly direction, 631.15 ft. to the southeasterly corner of Block 2; thence N50°04'53"E., 618.42 ft. to the southeasterly corner of Block 2; thence S30°50'55"W., 1627.72 ft. to the northeasterly corner of Block 2; thence S14°45'12"W., along a line partially identical with line 3-4 of U.S. Survey No. 4500 previously described, 425.39 ft. to corner No. 4 of said U.S. Survey No. 4500, thence along the line identical with line 4-1, 228.36 ft. to the Point of Beginning.

The area contained in Block 2 is 16,932 Acres, more or less.

Located within protected sections 3 & 4, Tract A, T17N, R12W, S.M. ALASKA.



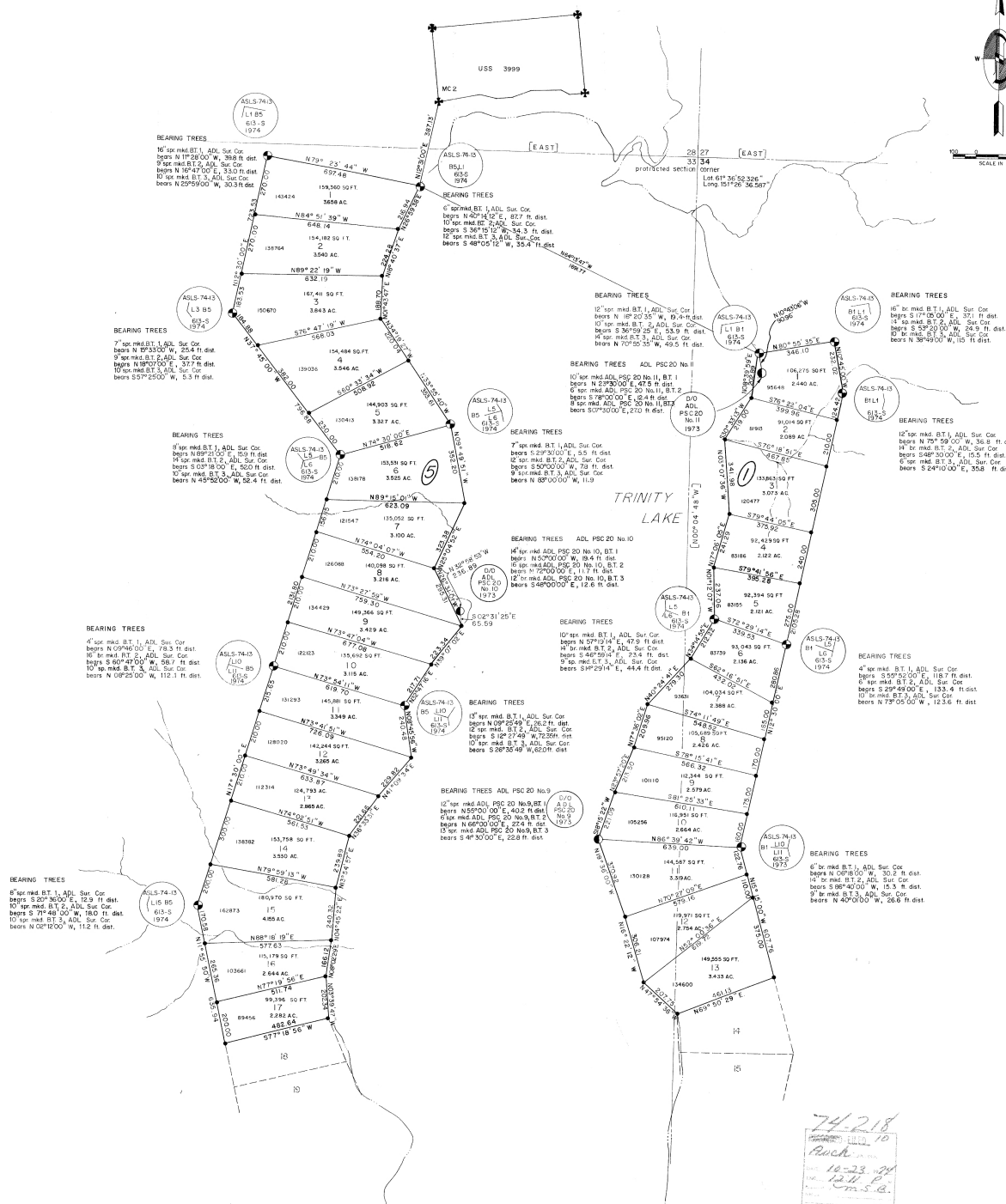
